- 1. R&D applications in which a portion of a circuit remains the same, but key components are modified for experiments.
- 2. Semiconductor companies who want to build first run reference design boards ahead of receiving the newly designed ICs can save time by having the boards fabricated ahead of time and adding the ICs when available. This saves 2 to 3 weeks of valuable time and allows them the confidence to build more of these boards initially.
- 3. Circuit boards in which certain components are not always populated give the flexibility of having only one SKU and adding components as needed.

The technology can be used for any surface mount components from small discrete components to BGAs.
