We have always tried to keep these inexpensive to add value to our core product. Currently, we sell a 10 pack with the headers for \$5 or a 100 pack for \$38. Due to a number of requests, we have just added 2" jumpers to our family that now includes 3", 5", and 7" options.

Here is a sneak peak of some of them: Once upon a time before SchmartBoard, the idea of hand soldering a 72 pin, .5mm pitch, QFP component was not something that many people would consider doing. We will release SchmartBoard|ez QFP boards to support up to 256 pins. These new boards will allow you to work with larger microprocessors, FPGAs and other advanced devices.
